Notice of Unclaimed Funds Proposed for Escheatment

This notice concerns the Superior Court of California, County of Lake's intent to escheat the sum of \$37,521.60 in the Court's Trust Fund that has remained unclaimed for a period exceeding three years. A list of these trust fund deposits is located [HERE](#).

Per Government Code Section 68081.1 "Except as otherwise provided by law, any money, excluding restitution to victims, that has been deposited with a Superior Court, or that a Superior Court is holding in Trust for the lawful owner, in a court bank account or in a court trust account in a county treasury, that remains unclaimed for three years shall become the property of the Superior Court or the State of California if, after published notice pursuant to this section, the money is not claimed or no verified complaint is filed and served."

The Court will publish a legal notice in the Lake County Record-Bee on September 17, 2024 and has sent letters to potential owners of these funds. If you believe that you are entitled to any of the funds, you must complete and submit a *Claim Affirmation Form* and *Claim for Money Held*. The Court will generally respond to the claim within 30 days. If your claim is accepted, you need to complete and submit a *Payee Data Record Form* available above, to receive a check for the amount claimed and earned interest. To expedite this process, it is recommended that you submit the *Payee Data Record Form* with your *Claim Affirmation Form* and *Claim for Money Held*. If your claim is rejected, you may file a verified complaint in the Superior Court of California, County of Lake (Government Code Section 68084.4(f)).

If no claim is filed by **November 5, 2024**, the money will become the property of the Court or the State. If a claim or claims are filed and approved for a portion of the money, any remaining unclaimed portion will become property of the Court or that State of California (Government Code Section 68084.1(f)).
